

Children's Program

On Sunday mornings programs start at 10:15 am. The children join their parent for the Eucharist and the rest of the 10:30 service. Grace teachers use "Living the Good News" as the curriculum along with many other resources for preschool through fifth grade.

During this year 2011-2012, we are developing our program for our children to help our sister parish in Haiti. Deacon Clelia Garrity shared pictures and information about children at St. Luc's school in Haiti and we are planning a fundraiser with the theme "Kids Helping Kids - Grace in the Desert - Circle of Love - St. Luc's". The children will sell chains cut by the children to make a chain of love and to send messages from the people of Grace in the Desert to St. Luc's of Haiti. The chain will be presented to Deacon Clelia with messages and funds to take to the children at school at St. Luc's, Haiti February 15th, 2012. This school and church was at the epicenter of the 2010 earthquake.

During the summer, activities were offered on Sunday mornings at 10:15 based on an Old Testament selection and craft activity.

We have offered special "Children's Days" with planned activities for the children. This past year we held one during April for an egg hunt and Easter activities. The second was held December 17th offering holiday activities and fun for the children while parents had shopping time. Our children also participate in retelling and story of Jesus' birth during the 10:30 service Dec 18th, 2011. We have planned trips to Boulder City to ride the historic train for special holidays.

Youth Programs

Youth group also meets on Sunday mornings at 10:15 in the conference room. This year they helped build the labyrinth, moving rocks and filling in the paths. They helped as readers for the Christmas pageant and with many service projects.

Nursery Program

Grace offers a children's nursery during the 9:00 and 10:30 services each Sunday. The children usually join their parents for the Eucharist and the rest of the service.
